

Greetings to you all in the matchless name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ!

"And this is the way to have eternal life—to know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, the one you sent to earth." (John 17:3)

Theology, the study of God, is essential for everyone. From an early age, we gain new knowledge about God through Sunday school, Bible studies, Sunday sermons, Bible classes, conventions, retreats, and organizational meetings. In addition to these formal learning opportunities, our life experiences and personal Bible reading also deepen our convictions about God. Despite its simplicity, it is the most profound book in the Christology (Theology of Christ). John's close relationship with Christ has provided us with deep insights into God's nature.

If we walk with Christ as John did, we too can gain a deep knowledge of God, which is the essence of theology. This journey of understanding and knowing God more deeply is the purpose of life that God has given us.

ക്രിസ്തുവേശുവിൽ ഏവർക്കും സ്നേഹവന്ദനം

"ഏക സത്യദൈവമായ നിന്നെയും നീ അയച്ചിരിക്കുന്ന യേശുക്രിസ്തുവിനെ യും അറിയുന്നതു നിത്യജീവൻ ആകുന്നു." (യോഹന്നാൻ 17 :3)

യോഹന്നാൻ ഒരു മീൻ പിടുത്തക്കാരനായിരുന്നു, എന്നാൽ യേശുവുമായുള്ള അവന്റെ കണ്ടുമുട്ടൽ അവനെ മാറ്റിമറിച്ചു. അവൻ യേശുവിനെ സ്നേഹിക്കു കയും അവന്റെ വാക്കുകൾ പൂർണമായി ശ്രവിച്ചു അതിന്റെ ആന്തരിക അർ ഥം ഗ്രഹിക്കുകയും ചെയ്തതിനാൽ അവൻ ക്രിസ്തുവിന്റെ പ്രിയ ശിഷ്യനായി. സുവിശേഷങ്ങളിൽ ലളിതമായ ഗ്രീക്ക് ഭാഷയിൽ എഴുതപ്പെട്ടിരിക്കുന്നത് യോഹന്നാന്റെ സുവിശേഷമാണ്. ഈ പുസ്തകത്തിന്റെ പദസമ്പത്തു ഏറ്റം ലളിതമാണ്, ഒരു മുക്കുവന്റെ അറിവിനൊത്ത പദസമ്പത്തു. എന്നാൽ ക്രിസ്തുവിജ്ഞാനീയത്തിൽ (Thelology of Christ) ഏറ്റം മികച്ച പുസ്തകവും ഇതുതന്നെ. യോഹന്നാന്റെ ക്രിസ്തുവിനോടു ചേർന്നു നടന്നു ലഭിച്ച ആഴമായ അറിവു നമുക്കോരോരുത്തർക്കും ദൈവത്തെ കുറിച്ചുള്ള ആഴമാർന്ന അറിവുനൽകാൻ ഇടയായി.

യോഹന്നാനെ പോലെ നാമും ക്രിസ്തുവിനോട് ചേർന്നു നടന്നാൽ ദൈവത്തെക്കുറിച്ചുള്ള ആഴമാർന്ന അറിവു (Theology) നേടുവാൻ സഹായിക്കും. ദൈവം നമുക്ക് നൽകിയിരിക്കുന്ന ജീവിതത്തിന്റെ ഉദ്ദേശവും ഇതുതന്നെയാണ്.

Saint Christopher

Saint Christopher, whose name means "Christ-Bearer" in Greek, lived in the 3rd century. According to legendary tales, he was initially called Reprobus. He was a well-built man, standing at 7.5 feet tall. His desire was to serve the greatest king, so he joined the service of the king of Canaan. However, one day he saw that the king feared the devil. Disillusioned, he left the king's service and joined a band of marauders, one of whom declared himself to be the devil. Later, Christopher learned that the devil feared the wayside cross and realized that the devil feared Christ. Determined to serve Christ, he left the marauders and asked people where he could find Christ.

Christopher met a hermit who instructed him in the Christian faith. When Christopher asked how he could serve Christ, the hermit suggested fasting and prayer. Christopher replied that he was unable to perform those services. The hermit then suggested that, due to his size and strength, Christopher could serve Christ by assisting people to cross a dangerous river. Christopher performed this service for some time. One day, a little child asked him to help him across the river. During the crossing, the river became swollen, and the child seemed as heavy as lead. Christopher struggled greatly and barely managed to carry the child across. When they reached the other side, Christopher said to the child: "You have put me in the greatest danger. I am Christ your king, whom you are serving by this work." The child then vanished.

Christopher later visited Lycia, where he comforted Christians who were being martyred. Brought before the local king, he refused to sacrifice to the pagan gods. The king tried to win him over with riches and by sending two beautiful women to tempt him. Instead, Christopher converted the women to Christianity, as he had already converted thousands in the city. The king then ordered his execution. Various attempts to kill him failed, but Christopher was eventually beheaded.

Saint Christopher is venerated as the patron saint of travelers and, beginning in the 20th century, of motorists. Despite his popularity, there is no certainty that he existed historically.


