Dearly beloved in Christ,

Greetings to you all in the matchless name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

It brings much happiness to communicate with you all through this issue of our very own Parish Journal. Salt and Light; is a challenge to us to think about the discipleship. We all are people of God and Disciples of Christ - Christians. What is the uniqueness and importance of salt and light, that Jesus wants us to be in this world? It will be easier for us to understand it through the statement of John MacArthur, he says that we can boil down the section of salt and light with one word: *influence*. Those who actually live the beatitudes are salt and light to the world, they will have an influence in the world. "A holy life will make the deepest impression. When we go deeper into the subject, what makes us think Jesus compared Christians to 'salt and light'? In the first century salt was essential to survival. It kept things from going bad. It was a preservative, it added taste, cleaned wounds and promoted healing. Jesus in his younger days have seen his mother using Salt and knew what it is. It was also used extensively in metallurgy, particularly in the refining of gold. So high was its value. Roman soldiers were often paid a salarium, an allowance of salt as their wage. From the word 'salarium' we get the English word salary. So when Jesus said, 'You are the salt of the earth' he was referring to something vitally important and essential for everyone.

Jesus also said, 'You are the light of the world.' Nothing grows, flourishes or survives without light. Just as Jesus is 'the Light of the World', with His Spirit in us, we are also lights to those around us. We should be prepared to bring spiritual light into the dark corners around us by living a life that is pleasing to God. Jesus makes it clear that being 'salt and light' is not just the occasional action, but that our whole lifestyle should demonstrates obedience and make us different from others. So it is a great responsibility that Christ has commissioned us being the salt and light. When Jesus spoke of salt, He was saying the world is decaying and When Jesus spoke of light He was saying that the world is in darkness. So, let do our part, Let our light shine as a mother;


when the opportunity knocks, don't be a coward. Use opportunities to glorify God. Fear God more than you fear man!

He sympathizes in your hopes and your temptations. He interests Himself in all your anxieties and remembrances, all the risings and fallings of your spirit. He encompasses you round and bears you in His arms. He notes your very countenance, whether smiling or in tears. He looks tenderly upon you. He hears your voice, the beating of your heart, and your very breathing. You do not love yourself better than He loves you. God has created me to do Him some definite service. He has committed some work to me which He has not committed to another. I have my mission. I may never know it in this life, but I shall be told it in the next. I am a link in a chain, a bond of connection between persons. He has not created me for naught. I shall do good; I shall do His work. I shall be an angel of peace, a preacher of truth in my own place, while not intending it if I do but keep His commandments. Therefore, I will trust Him, whatever I am, I can never be thrown away. If I am in sickness, my sickness may serve Him, in perplexity, my perplexity may serve Him. If I am in sorrow, my sorrow may serve Him. He does nothing in vain. He knows what He is about. He may take away my friends. He may throw me among strangers. He may make me feel desolate, make my spirits sink, hide my future from me. Still, He knows what He is about. -Amen






